

COMMON SIGNS OF CANCER IN PETS:

- Lumps and bumps on their body
- Sores that do not heal
- Bleeding or discharge from any opening in the body
- Persistent bad breath or offensive odors
- Unexpected weight loss
- Change in eating and/or bowel habits
- Labored breathing
- Persistent limping
- Difficulty breathing, urinating, or defecating
- Lethargy or unwilling to exercise
- Change in interaction with the family/ Hiding
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Bleeding from the nose or mouth
- Seizures

If your pet exhibits one or more of these signs, it is recommended that you consult your veterinarian to discuss a referral to an oncology specialists. Early detection is critical! Diagnosis of cancer is NOT a death sentence. Many types of cancer can be treated if diagnosed early. The specialty oncology team at VSNT is here to help you and your pet through the process.
